E-safety spotlight: Copyright and ownership

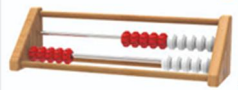
What things 'belong' to you at home? (e.g. toys, bedroom, other belongings)

We have also been exploring numbers to 20 and beyond as well as practising our quick recall of bonds to 5 and 10. We continue to compose and decompose quantities using the sentence stem: _ and _ makes _, _ is made from _ and _.
