What will we be learning this half term?

Welcome:

Phonics

From next week we will be beginning our phonics learning. We will start by learning phonemes s, a, t, p, i, n, m, n, d, g, o, c, k. Please remember to check Tapestry for our weekly phonics learning and don't forget to share your phonics practice at home!

Mathematics (Mastering Number)

We will be starting our number learning, we will be subitising numbers to 5 and finding out about the 5-ness of 5! The number blocks will help us along the way and we will be using our fingers, cubes and buttons to show different ways of making 3, 4, and 5.

As we move into Autumn we will be observing the changes, thinking about the weather and seasons. We will explore the school grounds to identify changes that will be occurring around us.

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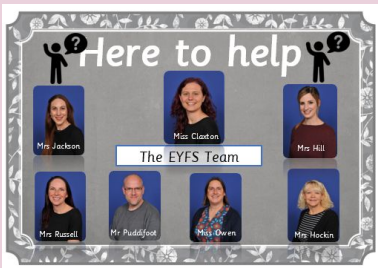

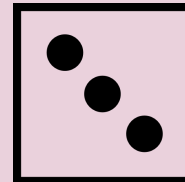
