#### Phonics - Little Wandle


At the Federation of Spixworth schools we follow Little Wandle Phonics.

Resources are used in Reception, Year 1/ Year 2 and continue to be used for those who need them at the Junior school.

In school we will learn 4 new sounds (phonemes) a week.

On a Friday your child will have a phonics folder containing practice sheets for home.

We will also put the phonics learning on Tapestry so that you can practice at home.



## Vocabulary

Helicopter stories- the children tell us a story, we record it (no more than a page) then as a class we act it out during a story acting session.

Story Scribes- your child will tell us a story and attempt to use their phonics to record sounds/ words they know.

The Write stuff - after October Half term we use the Write Stuff to build our vocabulary using Grandma Fantastic. In January we will start recording our ideas as sentences.



#### Focus child

We use a Focus child approach.

This means we focus our observations on a small group of children, we are still working with the whole cohort but we focus our observations on individuals for that week.

You will be notified of your child's focus week on the Friday before their week begins, please add anything from home.

The following Friday you will receive your child's tapestry observations. The following Monday you will receive feedback for your child including a learning journey sheet (via Tapestry).

# The First Few Weeks

The children will be busy making friends, getting to know our school, playing and learning.

They may be more tired than usual. We will provide quiet times as needed throughout the day.

We will carry out the Baseline assessment — this is an age-appropriate assessment of mathematics and literacy, communication and language (LCL). It is linked to the learning and development requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).

We will find out what the children already know and use this information to help us plan future learning for each child.

We would value any contributions you would like to make in helping us get to know your child's needs.
