What will we be learning this half term?

English

This half term we are going to be exploring writing recounts themed around 'A Walk in the Woods'. We will be recapping where the 'subject' and 'verb' go in a sentence and when to use a full stop, all whilst writing about wonderful autumnal woodlands!

Phonics/Spellings

Last half term in Year 1 we have been revisiting our Phase 3 graphemes and words. In Year 2, we have been revisiting our Phase 5 graphemes and words before we begin our Spelling Units this half term.

Mathematics

This half term Year 1 will be exploring addition and subtraction within 10 using part-whole models.

Year 2 will also be focusing on addition and subtraction, using number bonds to support with larger numbers before we move onto geometry and shape.

Science and Foundation Subjects

This half term in Science we are going to be continuing our learning all about plants and animals in our local area; by identifying and comparing them. Alongside this in Computing, we will be learning how to log on and use the Chromebooks safely, exploring Purple Mash and making some digital artwork!
