



What will we be learning this half term?

<u>English</u>

This half term we are writing a story based on 'The Marvellous, Fluffy, Squishy Itty-Bitty' by Beatrice Alemagna and thinking about how we can show love and care. We will also be writing a poem called 'If I were in Charge of the School'.

Phonics/Spellings

Year 1 are continuing to learn alernative graphemes for different phonemes this half term. Year 2 are carrying on with their daily spelling lessons. This half term they are learning why some words are spelt with kn, gn and wr; why we drop the 'e' when adding some suffixes and why /j/ can be spelt in different ways.

<u>Mathematics</u>

This half term Year 1 are representing, comparing and ordering numbers to 20. Year 2 are learning all about money, before moving on to multiplication and division.

Science and Foundation Subjects

This half term in Science we are going to be continuing our learning all about plants and animals, thinking about habitats and how climate affects living things. We are also looking out for signs of winter and spring outside. In Geography, we will be learning about the seven continents and five oceans, as well as where the hot and cold areas of the world are. In Computing, we are starting to explore programming using BeeBots.
