Phonics

This term we will be consolidating our knowledge of all the graphemes we have learnt and apply these to longer words. When reading longer words we **chunk** them - break them down into manageable chunks!

We will be securing all the tricky words we have learnt as well as practicing spelling our tricky words.

Mathematics (Mastering Number)

This half term we will be starting to think doubling quantities to 10, as well as starting to think about what makes a number even or odd.

English

This half term we are starting our weekly writing focus based around a text. Our first text will be 'How to make a chocolate mug cake'. Grandma Fantastic will introduce new vocabulary to us and we will use the new words in sentences. We will write our own instructions and recipe!
